My dear Sir:

In answer to your letter of the 15th instant, relative to shipping instructions on the 3/8-ton Ford bodies now coming through at your plant, I wish to inform you that there has been some delay due to the fact that it is necessary for us to make request on our Traffic Manager for routings and he, in turn, makes request on the Federal Traffic Board for movements involving in excess of one car load.

However, you should receive in the mail this morning, from the Purchasing Agent, routings covering 169 bodies, and it is hoped that shipping instructions on the balance of the order will be available prior to the time they are needed.
